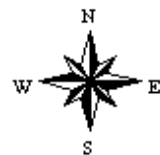
Topography Map

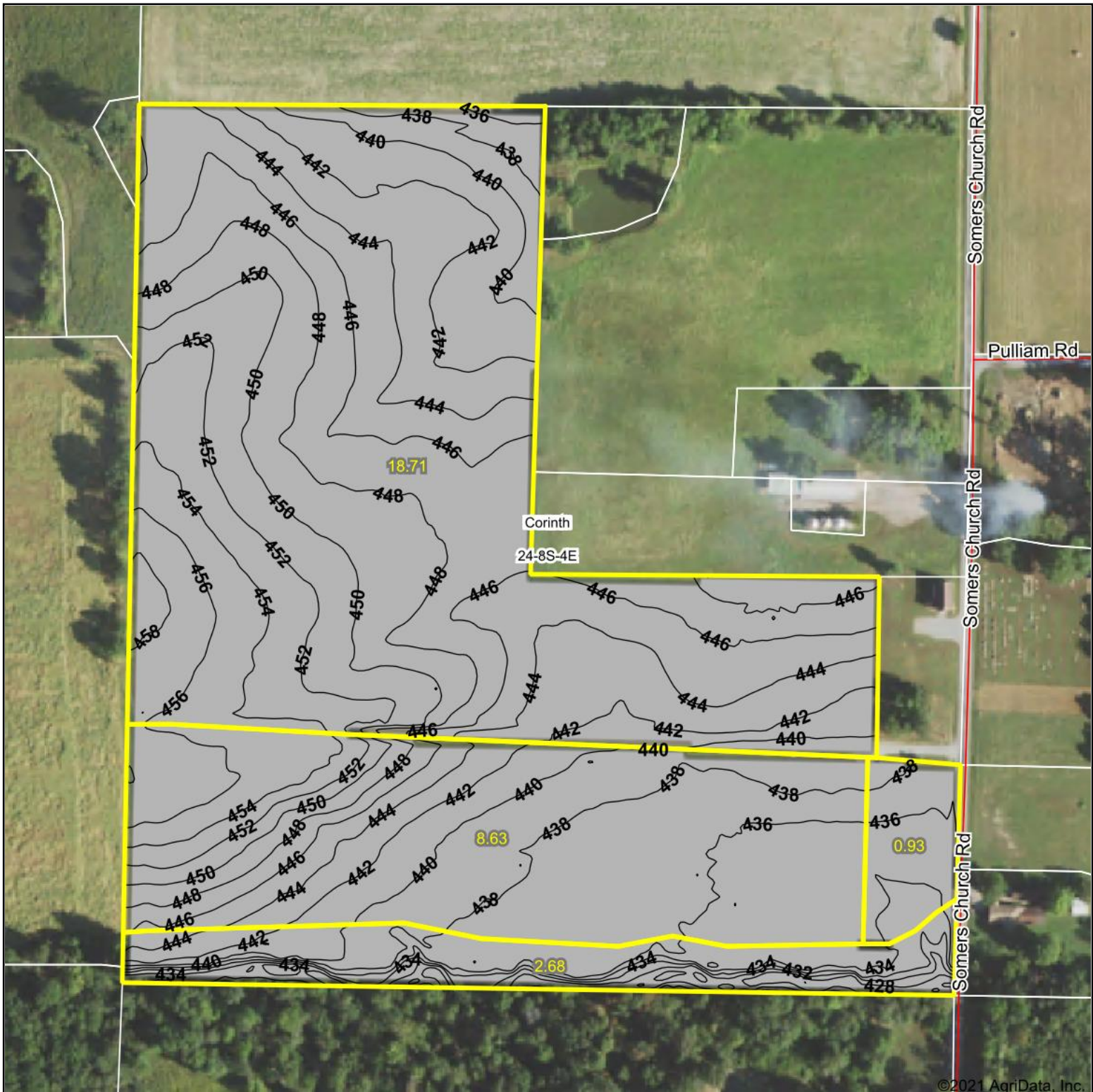

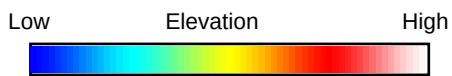

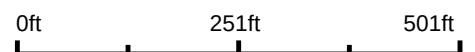
